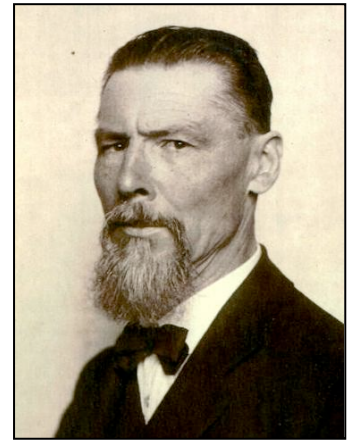
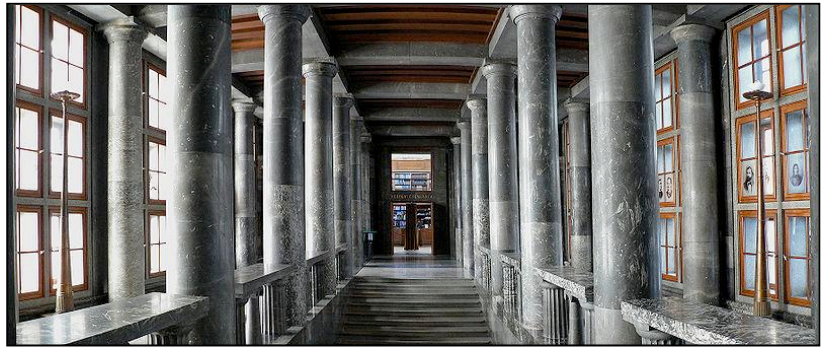
Program: Rolf Achilles on Joze Plecnik
